- Map out your route in advance & use a trusted map or GPS.
- Drive slowly on dirt roads.
- Absolutely no pets allowed.
- Wear good walking shoes.
- Keep children with you at all times.
- No smoking at the farms.
- Bring a cooler and basket or bag for purchases.
- Pack a picnic or purchase food along the trail; great food options available.
- Carry out anything you bring with you.
- Bring protection from the sun and layers for cool afternoons.
- Read itinerary closely. Some destinations are only open one day.

Print your Brown Paper Ticket as your passport to receive available discounts. Only one passport needed per car.

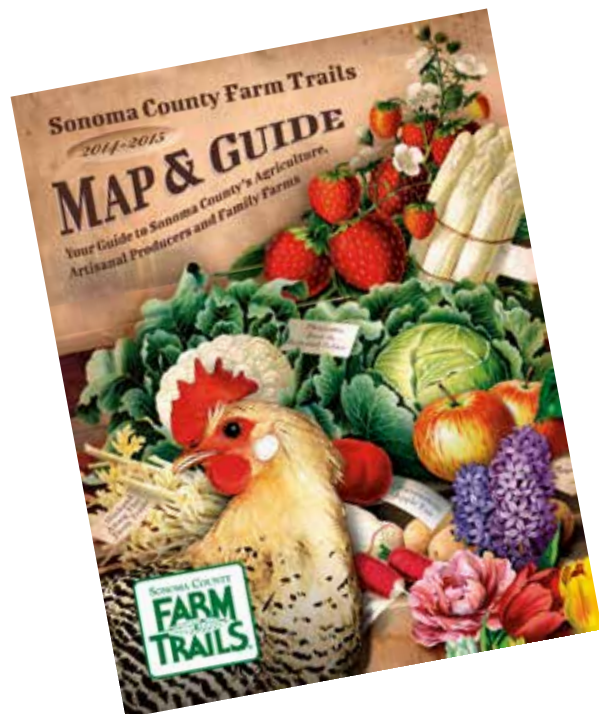
